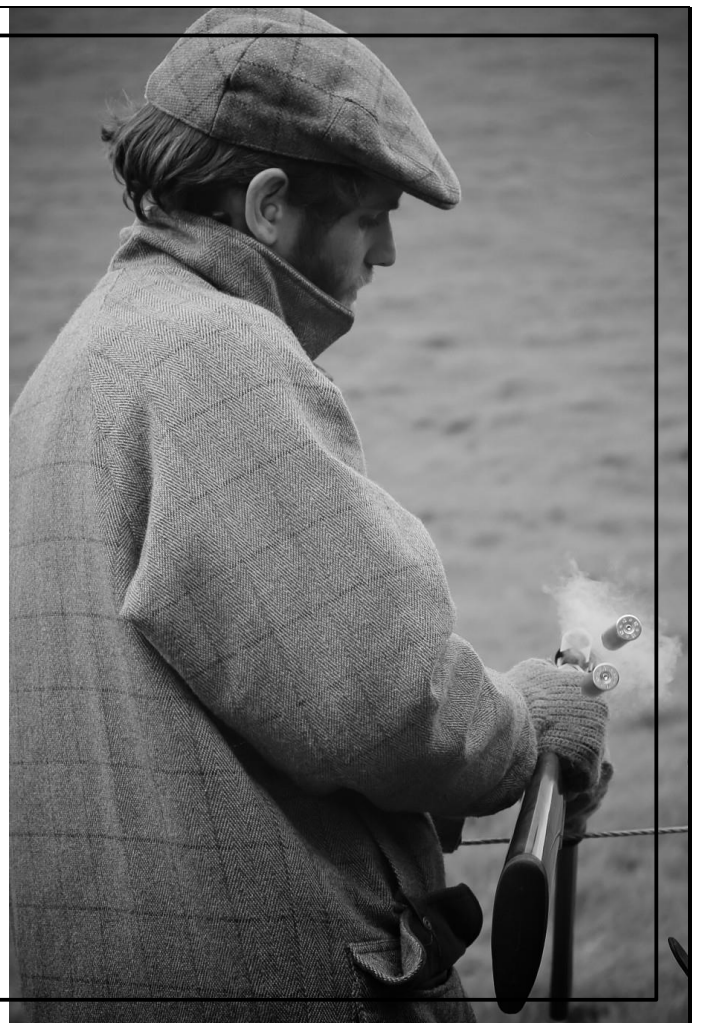

OVERVIEW

The Churchill Foundation and Quintessentially Foundation Shooting Challenge will be held on Thursday 18th May at Englefield Estate, Berkshire.

The annual Shooting Challenge, now in its 5th year, has raised over £500,000 to date, with proceeds helping a multitude of UK charities in desperate need of support.

The day brings everyone from key influencers, Quintessentially Members, renowned celebrities, shooting Olympians and novices alike, together for an unforgettable clay pigeon shooting challenge.

THE SHOOT

Thirty teams of four guns will shoot five simulated clay sporting "drives" each replicating different species of game birds.

The cost of all shooting, clays and cartridges, breakfast, mid morning snacks, champagne reception and a two-course seated lunch is included in team entry.

Team members are welcome to invite lunch guests. Following lunch there will be an auction, musical performance and prize giving.

Surprise entertainment continues throughout the day which in previous years has seen aerobatic displays, musical performances, stand up comic performances and much more.
