Registration Fee	The registration fee for this event is: £100
Minimum Pledge	Our ask is that you pledge to raise a minimum of £500 (excluding gift aid and any registration fee) in sponsorship money. However, this is not a cap and where possible please try to raise as much sponsorship money as possible to help with our vital work supporting veterans and their families. You may collect the sponsorship monies in any manner you wish, inclusive of a fundraising platform. Where the sponsorship money has been collected by you personally, you should arrange for this to be paid to WWTW within one month after the end of the Event. All funds raised through the Event must be payable to WWTW.
Age	The minimum age for the challenge is 18
Maximum Weight	15 Stone/ 95 KG

Changes, Postponement, or Cancellation:

Cancellation by you: If for whatever reason you make the decision to not take your place in the Event, your registration fee will not be refunded. However, if you cannot take part due to a reason such as injury, you may be able to transfer your place in the Event. Please contact us to discuss.

Cancellation or changes made by the Event Organiser: We have no control over the Event. The Event Organiser may need to make changes to, postpone, or cancel the Event due to circumstances outside their

control. Please see the Event Organiser's Terms and Conditions (linked above) for more information. The Event organiser will contact you if this happens.

Sponsorship money: If the Event is cancelled (and you don't transfer to another event), or you decide not to participate, you are responsible for contacting your sponsors to inform them that you are no longer taking part and for confirming with them whether they are happy for the money they have donated to still be given to WWTW. If you are using sponsorship forms for your fundraising, all sponsorship forms and monies collected should be forwarded to us or returned to your sponsors in accordance with their wishes.

Our Liability

WWTW are not the organiser of the Event and do not have any responsibility or liability in respect of running the Event. WWTW will not be responsible for injury or illness resulting from your participation or for any damage or losses outside of our control that is not foreseeable.

WWTW do not exclude or limit in any way our liability to you where it would be unlawful to do so, which includes liability for death or personal injury caused by our negligence or the negligence of our employees.

In addition, if we fail to comply with these terms, we are responsible for loss or damage you suffer that is foreseeable.

You undertake the Event entirely at your own risk and will not hold WWTW responsible for:

- Any damage to, or loss of personal property.
- Any accident or injury which does not result from the negligence of WWTW arising directly or indirectly or in any manner whatsoever out of or in connection with the Event.
- Any damage to vehicles, or property left within vehicles at the location of the Event.

Data Collection

During registration and participation of the Event, WWTW will collect personal data from you and your team members.

By registering to take part in the Event you understand and agree that:

- You understand it is necessary for WWTW to share your data (including medical information where applicable) with the Event organisers for you to participate in this event.
- You are consenting to receive email and postal communications from WWTW regarding the Event.
- We may process and use the personal data collected for administrative, research and publicity purposes.
- Where consent is given, we may use your details to send you information about future events which we think may be of interest to you and may opt out at any time by using the link provided.
- We do not sell or swap your details with any third parties, except the Event organiser and service companies authorised to act on our behalf to carry out our work.
- We will keep your details on our database so we can provide you with the best possible support every time you contact us.
